



Promoting the visual and other arts & culture in Bridge and district

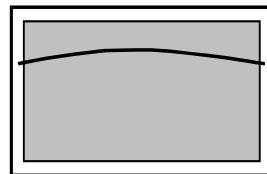
Our aim is to encourage everyone, young and old, from novice to accomplished artist, to make and exhibit their work.

All forms of visual arts and crafts (painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, craftwork, etc.) are welcome. The work can be unframed, un-conventional or even un-finished.

There are three display areas in the exhibition:-

Exhibits hanging on the chains on the walls:

These exhibits **MUST** be framed or rigidly mounted and provided with a **STRONG CORD** securely fitted across the full width of the back, as shown.



Display boards: These are suitable for un-mounted or lightly mounted works on paper, onto the rear of which we can stick pads.

Tables: For exhibits not suitable for the walls or display boards.

Do invite your family, friends and contacts to visit the exhibition again after 5.00 pm on Saturday when there will be music, a complimentary drink and snacks

Entry Conditions

Artists may submit, at their own risk, up to **three** works of visual arts and crafts. Artists are encouraged to price their work for sale.

All work must be original (where derived from other work the source must be acknowledged, no prints accepted, except mono-prints and artist's proof) and must not have been previously submitted to Art in Bridge.

The artist must live, work or study within 5 miles of Bridge in a **rural** Parish.

A fully completed entry form must accompany the work. All work must be labelled on the back with Title & Artist's name.

We will endeavour to accept all submitted work and exhibit it to its best advantage. However the organisers reserve the right not to hang any work that they deem to be unsuitable due to its content, format, size, weight etc.. Due to limitations on space it may prove impossible to display all accepted exhibits. The selection and positioning of exhibits will be entirely at the discretion of the organisers.

For adults only: £1 per exhibit

No commission will be charged on sales made during the exhibition.

Visitors will be invited to vote for their favourite exhibit. The exhibits receiving the most votes will be announced after the close of the exhibition.

INSURANCE

Neither the organisers (Art in Bridge) nor Bridge Village Hall Management Committee can accept any liability for loss of, or damage to, exhibits. Exhibitors showing valuable work should provide their own insurance cover.
