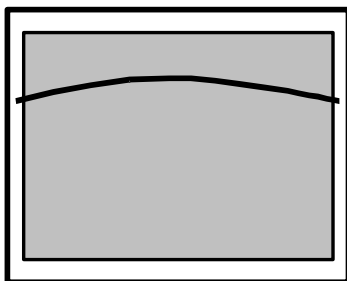




The aim of the exhibition is to encourage everyone, young and old, from novice to accomplished professional, to exhibit their photographic art.

All Exhibits must be framed or very rigidly mounted. No 'Clip' type frames please.

Frames/mounts must be at least 20x20cm (8x8 inches), with a strong cord securely fitted well above the middle, across the full width (as shown) ready for hanging on the chains on the wall.

Entry Conditions

Anyone, living, working or studying within 5 miles of Bridge, in a **rural** Parish, may submit up to **three photographs** in frames/mounts of not less than **20x20cm** (8x8 inches), ready for hanging on the chains on the wall (see overleaf for details). You are encouraged to price your exhibits for sale.

A fully completed Entry Form must accompany the exhibits. All work must be labelled on the back with the title & contact name.

We will endeavour to accept all submitted entries and exhibit them to their best advantage. However the organisers reserve the right not to exhibit any work that they deem to be unsuitable due to its content, format, size, weight etc.. Due to limitations on space it may prove impossible to display all accepted exhibits. The selection and positioning of exhibits will be entirely at the discretion of the organisers. The organisers reserve the right to use low resolution photographs of exhibits on their web site and publicity.

Children's entries are free; else £1 per exhibit. No commission will be charged on sales made during the exhibition. There will be a Catalogue of Exhibits.

Young artists will be entered into a draw with a chance to win a £10 art materials token donated by *The Arts Society Canterbury*; one for secondary school pupils and one for younger children.

Visitors to the Exhibition will be invited to vote for their favourite exhibit and the result will be posted on the web site.
